

**PUBLIC SAFETY
FEBRUARY 14, 2012**

- Call to order** The meeting was called to order by Chairman Kersten Rocksvold at 9:30 a.m. Committee members Joe Hartley, Greg Russell, Mary Jane Faas and Marge Sheckler were present. Clerk Janet Geisler and Sheriff McCullick were also present.
- Verify posting** The Chairman verified that the meeting notice was properly posted.

- App of Minutes** Faas moved, Sheckler seconded to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.
- Coroner** Hartley moved, Rogers seconded to approve the Coroner's bills. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.
- Juvenile Court
Worker** Kathy Quamme reported that Girl Power consisting of students from Seneca and North Crawford is wrapping up. Teen Court has been meeting once a month. A listing of truancy contacts per school was provided.
- 911** Julie Cipra, 911 Coordinator, reported on the recent outage at the Communication Center which was down for about 2 ½ hours. She reported that her GPS system is no longer working and a new one needs to be purchased. She had sufficient funds in several of her 2011 accounts to carry forward to cover the costs, however the Finance Committee is requiring her to use funds from her 2012 accounts and if she runs short that the money will come from the Contingency Fund.
- Sheckler moved, Faas seconded to approve the 911 and Communication Center bills. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.
- Em. Govt.** Roger Martin reported that the All Hazards Mitigation Plan public hearing was held in Seneca as required. There were a total of six people in attendance. The County Board will have to approve the plan after it has been reviewed by the State. Roger further reported that the backup plan in place worked well when the Communication Center went down.

Russell moved, Hartley seconded to approve the Emergency Government bills. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

Sheriff

Faas moved, Hartley seconded to approve the Sheriff's bills. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.
