Land Use CONCERNS
July 13, 2010

The July 13, 2010 meeting of the Land Use Concerns committee was called to order by the Chair, Henry Esser at 9:07 a.m. Esser verified the posting of the agenda. Other members present Harriet Behar; Wade Dull, and David Olson.

A motion was made by Behar, seconded by Dull to approve the agenda and minutes as mailed. The motion carried.

Bill Howe was also present.

Gionne Collins

Collins reported that assessment rolls are still being worked on. The large printer in her office is still not working. Repairs to machine are pending. She will be starting foreclosures on delinquent tax properties. Behar moved and Dull seconded to pay the bills as presented. The motion carried unanimously upon roll call.

John Rybarczyk

Rybarczyk reported a letter from the lawyer on the reasonable cost language stated there was no reason to change. He reported the 28 soil tests and 29 sanitary permits (18 new & 11 replacement). Septic system and inventory maintenance program dates have been changed-inventory is due 2013 and maintenance 2015. No announcement on the Shore Land Zoning ordinance revision will be made till August but appears as though it should be fully funded. Use value assessment for farm land was discussed. Final Determination was finalized and sent to the office. It must be taken care of within 6 mos. A public hearing is set for September 14. Olson moved and Esser seconded to pay the presented bills. The motion carried unanimously upon roll call.

Rich Marks

Marks reported on Remounmentation Program progress. There are discrepancies with the corner placement and will be working on correcting this. He suggested that the data should be online. Behar moved and Olson seconded to pay the bills as presented. The motion carried unanimously upon roll call.

The committee set their next meeting date for Wednesday August 11 at 3:00pm at the County Fair.

Dull moved and Behar seconded to adjourn. The motion carried.
