Immunizations for Diphtheria, Whooping Cough (pertussis) and Tetanus, Polio, Measles, Mumps, Rubella, HIB, Hepatitis B, Tdap, Pneumococcal Conjugate, HPV and Chickenpox will be offered at all the centers. **Chickenpox vaccine is offered by appointment only**, due to fragile nature of the vaccine. Please bring your child's previous immunization records to each clinic site. During a whooping cough outbreak Tdap (Tetanus-Diphtheria-Pertussis) will be offered free of charge to everyone. Donations accepted to defray costs.
