Optimizing plant growth requires balancing protection criteria with design attributes. Miracle Tube designs have an ivory color to prevent the absorption and retention of excessive heat. This protector also has the right amount of translucency to admit the proper amount of light and contains the perfect amount of venting. This concept allows the ideal amount of fresh air to circulate throughout the tube.

- Solid tubes furnished in nested groups of five units
- Sturdy, vented shelters available in 2 ft., 3 ft., 4 ft., 5 ft., and 6 ft. sizes
- Diameters range from 3.5 to 4.25 inches
- Has rolled top to eliminate limb damage

Jump Start

Every design aspect of the Jump Start tree shelter has a single purpose: to get a tree off to a fast, healthy start and shorten the labor-intensive establishment phase of the overall project. The proprietary peach color optimizes red light for increased biomass growth, while the twin-walled construction diffuses light to increase light absorption and photosynthesis.



- Sturdy, vented shelter available in 4 ft., 5 ft., and 6 ft. sizes
- Ships flat in compact stacks; pops open to solid tube
- All tubes are 3.9 inches in diameter for optimal, consistent growth with balanced root to shoot ratio

Weed Mat Squares



Stop weeds in their tracks. Woven poly plastic mats can be applied directly over brush and stubble.

Apply once and weed control is done. Mat will biodegrade in 3 to 5 years. The mats block weeds by blocking 99% of light while allowing water, nutrients, and air to pass through to your seedling. Sold in bundles of 25.

- Porous to air and water, while blocking 99% of light.
- Woven poly plastic, available in 3 ft. and 4 ft. squares.
- L-shaped center slit to accommodate tree and shelter
- Includes sod staples to secure to ground

Plantskydd

Developed in Sweden in 1991 to protect tree plantations from deer, moose, and rabbits while also meeting strict environmental laws, Plantskydd is now made in the USA from 100% natural ingredients (dried porcine and/or bovine blood, vegetable oil, and water). Repels animals by emitting an odor that causes a fear response in browsing animals because of its association with predator activity.



- Lasts up to 6 months over winter, 3-4 months during the growing season
- 100% organic, OMRI listed
- Concentrated formula, acts as fertilizer

All of the shelters are designed to last at least four years and include bird netting to prevent cavity nesting bird species from entering the shelters.
