



## ***Animal Waste Storage Facility Abandonment Plan Checklist***

(Plans are to conform with NRCS Standards 313, 634, and 590. At a minimum, the plan must include the following items)

- [ ] 1. A description of the type and size of the storage facility and an estimate of the amount of waste in the facility.
- [ ] 2. A description of where and how the manure and manure saturated soil will be removed and spread.
- [ ] 3. A description of where and how a liner (if present) is disposed.
- [ ] 4. A description of how a transfer system (if present ) is disposed.
- [ ] 5. A description of how the excavated area will be filled and the location of the fill material.
- [ ] 6. A plan view showing the final grade, the area to be reseeded, and subsequent runoff flow.
- [ ] 7. Certification stamped by a registered profession engineer, or signed by a Department of Agriculture Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP), Land Conservation Department (LCD) or Natural Resource Conservation Service (NRCS) certified Agricultural Engineering Practitioner that the plan meets the requirements of the ordinance.
