

The Crawford County Highway Committee held a special meeting on Thursday, March 24, 2016 at the Crawford County Administration Building in Prairie du Chien, WI.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Tom Cornford at 10:00 a.m. Proof of Publication was verified by Tom Cornford.

Henry Esser made a motion to approve the Agenda, seconded by David Olson. Motion carried by a voice vote. Members present were: Tom Cornford, Henry Esser, David Olson and Gerry Krachey. Wade Dull was excused. Also present were Commissioner Dennis Pelock, State Superintendent Todd Myers and Shop Superintendent Cory Folbrecht. Julie Check was present to take meeting minutes.

The committee reviewed the February invoice from Peterson, Antoine & Peterson.

Local Projects:

- CTH S, Bridge P-12-0109, Project ID: B-12-0190 - Commissioner Pelock discussed his meeting with the Jenson brothers. The committee approved Commissioner Pelock moving ahead with Right of Way negotiations with the Jenson brothers and approved the county purchasing a 20 ft. piece of 8 ft. culvert for this property negotiations.
- CTH D, Project ID: 12510 CHIP:
  - **Pulverizing Bids** - The only bid received was from The Kraemer Company for approximately 6.5 miles at \$3,725.00 per mi. Gerry Krachey made a motion to approve the pulverizing bid from The Kraemer Company for approximately 6.5 miles at \$3,725.00 per mi., seconded by David Olson. Motion carried by a roll call vote. (See Attachment A)
  - **Aggregate Gravel Bids** - The only bid received was from The Kraemer Company -  $\frac{3}{4}$ " base aggregate dense \$6.00/ton or \$8.10 per cu yd., out of the O'Connell Quarry. Henry Esser made a motion to approve the aggregate gravel bid from The Kraemer Company for \$6.00/ton, \$8.10 per cu. yd. from the O'Connell Quarry, seconded by David Olson. Motion carried by a roll call vote. (See Attachment B)

Bids, Proposals or Sales:

**Oil Bids:** Todd Seeley from H. G. Meigs was present. Oil bids from H. G. Meigs and Flint Hills Resources were reviewed. (See attachments C and D). **Todd Seeley from H. G. Meigs said they will match Flint Hills Resources prices.** David Olson made a motion to approve the oil bid proposals from both firms and split the road oil and emulsion needed for summer projects between the two companies at the discretion of the Highway Commissioner, seconded by Henry Esser. Motion carried by a roll call vote.

Bids, Proposals or Sales: (continued)

**Oil Bids:** (continued) The committee discussed the letter received from Flint Hills Resources that their company no longer accepts checks. After reviewing the letter the committee agreed that if Flint Hills no longer accepts checks for payment then the Highway Department will no longer do business with them. (See attachment E)

**Asphalt Bids:** Jared Baranczyk from Iverson Construction was present for the asphalt bids. The bid from Iverson Construction was the only asphalt bid received. (See attachment F). Jared explained that their price is the same from all plants. They will have a plant in Fennimore most of the year and possibly in Prairie du Chien towards the end of the year. David Olson made a motion to accept the asphalt bid from Iverson Construction, seconded by Gerry Krachey. Motion carried by a roll call vote.

**Chip Bids:** Robin Davis from The Kraemer Company was present for the chip bids. Chip bids from The Kraemer Company and Fahrner Asphalt were reviewed. (See attachments G and H). Henry Esser made a motion to approve chip bid proposals from both firms and to purchase chips for the construction season from the firm that is most advantageous to Crawford County, seconded by Gerry Krachey. Motion carried by a roll call vote.

**Culvert Bids:** Culvert bids from Contech and Metal Culverts were reviewed. (See attachments I and J). Henry Esser made a motion to purchase culverts through the construction season from the firm that is most advantageous to Crawford County, seconded by David Olson. Motion carried by a roll call vote.

**Loader Bids:** Rollie Aspenson from Brooks Tractor, Brad Devault from Fabick and Don Benz from Titan Machinery were present for the loader bids. The committee reviewed the bids. The salesmen each gave a brief explanation of their loader, warranty and options. Bid prices include L-2180 scale, LP 950 printer and trading in #262 621D loader. Loader bid proposals are:

**Brooks:** **John Deere 2016 624K**, 2 yr. full warranty/1500 mi., L-2180 scale & LP 950 printer - \$134,700.00.

**Fabic:** **Cat 2016 938M**, 2 yr. full warranty, L-2180 scale and LP 950 printer - \$130,325.00.

**Titan:** **Case 2016 721F**, 5 yr./3,000 mi warranty, oil & filter for 3 years, L-2180 scale and LP 950 Printer - \$134,415.50.

**Titan:** **USED 2014 721F**, 3 yr./3,000 mi full coverage warranty, with new bucket, L-2180 scale and LP 950 Printer - \$111,415.50.

David Olson made a motion to purchase the used 2014 Case 721F from Titan for the price of \$111,415.50 (price includes full coverage warranty 3 yr./3,000 mi., new bucket L-2180 scale and LP 950 printer), this motion is with the stipulation that the machine is in acceptable condition like presented to committee. If the used loader is not

acceptable to Shop Superintendent Cory Folbrecht upon delivery, then Cory has the authority to deny the machine. The county will then purchase from Fabick the new 2016 Cat 938M loader for \$130,325.00, seconded by Henry Esser. Motion carried by a roll call vote.

Old Business: Guest Rick Satterlee from Ayres Associates explained that Ayres Associates has completed design of Town of Freeman, Sugar Creek Bible Camp Bridge and Approaches. There will be a May letting, bridge should be built and project complete prior to Sugar Creeks 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebration. He also let the committee and the commissioner know that Ayres appreciated being given the chance to do this project.

At 11:09 a.m. with no further business, Gerry Krachey made a motion to adjourn, seconded by David Olson. Motion was carried by a voice vote and the meeting was adjourned.




