The son worked with his father and would like to take over the project. Work was to have begun this week as they had just finished a project in Steuben. Dale is re-evaluating the project and will determine if he feels Action Earthmovers will be able to handle all aspects of the project without Jim Morgan being in charge or if he needs to become more involved in the process of contacting landowners, or if we need to rebid, etc. The state has been notified of this complication and if we had to rebid the project would have to be extended and it was to have been completed by the end of October.
