

CRAWFORD COUNTY LAND CONSERVATION DEPARTMENT
LAND USE CONCERNS
January 20, 2015

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Esser at 9:00 a.m. Esser verified the posting of the agenda. Members present for roll call were Henry Esser, Harriet Behar, David Olson, Wade Dull and Jerry Achenbach was introduced and welcomed to the committee as the new FSA representative replacing Stephen Kvigne.

Esser indicated since it is a new year we need to be reminded that we agree to disagree in a friend manner and that visitors presentations are not to exceed 5 minutes.

A motion was made by Olson to approve the agenda as posted and minutes as mailed. Behar seconded. Motion carried.

GIGI COLLINS, Property Lister

Gigi stated tax bills were sent out. Thirteen out of the 40 delinquent tax properties have been paid in full. No judgments have been made on any properties as holding off until February in case a few more will be paid to prevent foreclosure. Her office has been working on the workbooks for assessors. The state requested all of our parcel maps so they could be placed on a statewide website; they still want each county to have their own parcel maps on a county website as well. Gigi indicated the office received their grant in the amount of \$76,080 and approximately \$40,000 will be used for aerial photo maps and the rest for Richard and the remonumentation project. Working on the conversion and Rich got all the maps up to Pro-West to work on them; hope to get the project done in 2015.

Motion by Dull to approve the Paul & Thomas Sampson, Town of Freeman CSM contingent upon the reviewing agency, second by Olson. Motion carried unanimously.

Behar made the motion to approve bills as presented, second by Olson, approved unanimously by roll call vote.

JOHN RYBARCZYK- Zoning and Sanitation Department

John presented a notice from the BNSF Railroad for a high speed crossover (side switching track) that would impact .28 acres of wetland at the BNSF Mile Post 244. The project is located in Eastman Township where State Highway 35 and County Road N intersect.

Bills were presented and motion to approve made by Dull, seconded by Behar and approved unanimously by roll call vote.

RICH MARKS- Surveyor

Rich indicated he is still working on Freeman Township but hopes to be done shortly.
