DHS supports the CDC recommendation that everyone ages 5 years and older get their primary series of COVID-19 vaccine, and everyone ages 12 years and older also receive a booster.

You are eligible for a 2nd COVID-19 booster if you:

- Are 50 years of age or older and got your first booster at least 4 months ago
- Are moderately or severely immunocompromised, 12 years of age or older, and got your first booster at least 4 months ago
- Got 2 doses of J&J/Janssen vaccine at least 4 months ago

Eligible individuals may choose which vaccine product they receive as a booster dose. Some people may prefer the vaccine product that they received for their primary series, and others may prefer to get a different product for their booster. If you are unsure as to which booster you want call our office at 608-326-0229

Additional doses are also available for people who are moderately to severely immunocompromised. Eligible people can get an additional mRNA dose 28 days after completing their initial two-dose mRNA COVID-19 vaccine series.
