

The Crawford County Highway Committee held their regular meeting on April 17, 2015 at the Crawford County Administration Building in Prairie du Chien, WI.

The meeting was called to order by Tom Cornford at 9:32 a.m. Proof of Publication was verified by Tom Cornford. Members present were: Tom Cornford, David Olson, Henry Esser and Wade Dull and Gerald Krachey. Also present was Commissioner Dennis Pelock and Shop Superintendent Cory Folbrecht. Julie Check was present to take minutes.

The agenda was approved with a motion made by Henry Esser and seconded by Wade Dull. Motion was carried by a voice vote.

A motion to approve the minutes from the last meeting on March 19, 2015 was made by Henry Esser, seconded by David Olson. Motion was carried by a voice vote.

Invoice voucher numbers: 172-196 & 199-252 and Payroll voucher numbers 170&171 & 197&198 were approved with a motion made by Gerald Krachey, seconded by David Olson to authorize payment. Motion was carried by a roll call vote.

Fund Balances were reviewed.

State Trunk Highways:

The PDC state salt shed is moving forward according to Greg Jewell, he received letter from DNR and everything is in good shape on that.

Towns/Village/City Projects & Issues:

The committee discussed the changes the Town of Wauzeka would like to make to the Winter Maintenance contract and why the committee wants the contract to stay as it is. Commissioner Pelock will discuss this with the Town of Wauzeka at their next meeting.

Sugar Creek Bridge and Approaches, Project ID: 5327-00-02/72 – The Town of Freeman committee members prefer 24' for the bridge width. Commissioner Dennis Pelock had previously discussed this project with Frank Weeks and Blair Dillman to see if they would be interested in donating to the Sugar Creek Bridge and Approaches project. Prior to this meeting Frank Weeks had committed to donating \$5,000 to Sugar Creek to be used for this project which would fund the bridge width of 28 feet.. Commissioner Pelock had not heard back from Blair Dillman yet.

Local Projects & Bridges:

Commissioner Dennis Pelock met with Michael Erickson at the WisDot office on Thursday in La Crosse, WI. The committee received a hand out showing the County & Local bridge projects. There are 22 deficient bridges in the local system. Michael Erickson from WisDOT will be recalculating the funding, due to non-allocation of money from several projects that had changes. July is the deadline for request of funding through the STP Bridge Program and Highway Program.

CTH S Bridge P-12-0109 – Greg Jewell discussed with the committee the letter the Highway Department received from Continental Western Group insurance company (claimant Big Gain). Greg Jewell discussed the offer the insurance company made and where he should proceed from here. The committee agreed to have Greg Jewell get a packet together and then set up a meeting with the insurance company.

Local Projects & Bridges: (continued)

CTH U Bridge #P-12-903 – Michael Mertens did interm inspections. Sufficiency is 39. This bridge needs a weight restriction put on it. Greg Jewell will give the county a recommended weight limit.

- Working with WisDOT on STH 35 box culvert

- CTH E, Plainview – Maple and Pleasant Mound Intersection Project- The contract from Pustina Construction, hired by the hour, was approved to be signed.

Consider Bids & Proposals for County Projects:

After reviewing the culvert bids from Metal Culverts Inc., and Contech Construction Products Inc, Henry Esser made a motion to purchase culverts through the construction season from the firm that is most advantageous to the county, seconded by Wade Dull. Motion carried by a roll call vote. (See attachments 1 and 2)

Oil Bids: Bill Lawton from Meigs was present for the oil bids. Oil bids from Flint Hills and Meigs were reviewed. (See attachments A and B)

Mr. Lawton from H. G. Meigs, LLC. said Meigs will match the price Flint Hills bid. Henry Esser made a motion to approve the bid proposals for both firms and split the road oil and emulsion needed for summer projects between the two companies at the discretion of the Highway Commissioner, seconded by David Olson. Motion carried by a roll call vote.

Asphalt Bids: Jared Baranczyk from Iverson Construction was present for the Asphalt Bids. Asphalt bids from Iverson Construction and Scott Construction were reviewed. (See attachments C and D)

David Olson made a motion to approve asphalt proposals from both firms and to purchase asphalt for the construction season from the firm that will be most advantageous to Crawford County, seconded by Gerry Krachey. Motion carried by a roll call vote

Personnel & Personnel Issues:

Henry Esser made a motion to hire one more summer college student, seconded by Wade Dull. Motion carried by roll call vote. The committee also discussed the wage schedule for the one CDL/non-college part-time employee (retiree) they previously approved of hiring.

Summer hours will start April 20, 2015 and continue thru September or October 2015.

Bids, Proposals or Sales:




