

CRAWFORD COUNTY HUMAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT
BOARD MEETING MINUTES
April 11, 2022

The regular meeting of the Crawford County Human Services Board was held on Monday, April 11, 2022 in person and via electronic videoconferencing/teleconferencing at the Crawford County Administration Building, Prairie du Chien, Wisconsin. The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Chairperson, Dull.

Roll call showed board members Ellen Brooks, Wade Dull, Elling Jones, Mary Kuhn, Linda Munson, Joyce Roth and Brad Steiner present along with non-board members Dan McWilliams, Director, and Mary Glawe, Clerk III.

Motion by Munson, second by Brooks to approve the March 14, 2022 minutes as mailed. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Munson, second by Steiner to approve the bills for \$13,501.28. Motion carried unanimously.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT

2021 Human Services Annual Report

The 2021 Human Services Annual Report was presented and discussed. Human Services programs served an additional 100 cases in 2021, with slight increases in all programs. WHEAP Crisis funding was increased to provide money to extra households. Additional revenue was received through ARPA funds resulting in less expenses. Medicaid and third-party revenue was more than budgeted. Motion by Munson, second by Dull to submit the 2021 Human Services Annual Report to the Crawford County Board as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Opioid SUD Room and Board Grant Award

New in 2022, SUD Grant funding can be used to pay room and board for Medicaid recipients. We applied for and received \$14,000 to be used for room and board. We encourage outpatient therapy first. This funding comes from Wisconsin's share of the Opioid Settlement.

Therapist Recruitment Update

We have received four applications of qualified candidates for the vacant therapist position. Interviews will be held the week of 04/18/22. Linda Munson will sit in on the interviews.

Agency Updates

The State was here for recertification of the Mental Health Clinic in Crisis, CSP, SUD and Mental Health services. No citations were granted, and we were recertified for two more years.
