September 14, 2017

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Esser at 9:00 a.m. Esser verified the posting of the agenda. Members present for roll call were Henry Esser, David Olson, Don Dudenbostel, Harriet Behar and Wade Dull.

A motion was made by Olson to approve the minutes as mailed. Behar seconded. Motion carried.

Kickapoo River Clean Up, Dale Klemme

Klemme indicated October 31, 2017 is the end date for the grant completion and suggest we ask for an extension to December 31, 2017. Earth Movers plan to get started the beginning of next week. We need to extend the contract with Earth Movers to October 31, 2017 as it was originally through February 20, 2017. If our grant is extended to December 31, 2017 then we will extend Earth Movers contract also to that date. Discussion of cost of jam removal.

Motion by Dull to approve extending the Earth Movers contract to October 31, 2017 and increase price per jam from \$900 to \$1,000, second by Behar. Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote.

GIGI COLLINS, Property Lister (not present)

Jodi Petsche presented copies of the 2018 Property Tax Lister and Surveyor Budgets. All is the same except for an increase in the maintenance of the Transcendent program to \$21,850.00.

Motion by Dull to approve both the Property Lister and Surveyor budgets as presented, second by Behar. Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote.

Motion by Olson to pay bills as presented, second by Dudenbostel. Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote.

Jake Shedivy, Land Conservation/Zoning Department (not present)

Troester indicated Jake is attending the WI Code Administrators meeting at Dodgeville today. The office has been very busy. Jake plans on attending the Fall Meeting of WI Code Administrators on October 12 & 13 in Merrimac. The department will be working on developing a plan to notify and explain the Septic System Maintenance Program to individuals.

Motion by Olson to approve bills as presented, second by Behar. Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote.

RICH MARKS/DAN MARKS- Surveyor

Dan Marks stated Bridgeport was almost completed this last month. Motion by Dull, second by Behar to pay Valley Land Survey, LLC, bills as presented. Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote.

Greg and Cindy Robertson, Township of Prairie du Chien, attended the meeting and were asking for direction as to who to contact to find out details of land sold behind their home to the BNSF Railroad Company and if it had to be rezoned from farmland to industrial. The committee informed them this would be an issue that needed to be addressed by the township and they were given the information of names and phone numbers of the people to contact in their township.
