Gigi indicated that Mark Peterson had sent out 3 eviction notices to individuals on the delinquent tax listing that were homesteads. Gigi stated they have been receiving training on the Parcel Data Development & Maintenance in ArcGis Software. It is a learning process for everyone and will take time and patience to learn the new system.

JOHN RYBARCZYK- Zoning and Sanitation Department

After the public hearing at the July meeting, final changes to the Floodplain Ordinance were presented. Add section 7.7 Fees and delete all references to a Board of Appeals and Stats 60/61/62 for towns/villages/cities. For mapping, we reference 101 FEMA flood insurance maps and the dam analyses for the Lourie and Blackhawk Kickapoo dams.

Motion by Behar to sign and recommend to county board the Ordinance Repealing and Recreating Chapter 20 of the Crawford County Code of Ordinances, the Floodplain Zoning Ordinance, with these changes. Second by Olson. Motion carried.

Bills were presented and motion to approve made by Behar, second by Achenbach. Motion carried unanimously by roll call vote.

RICH MARKS- Surveyor

Rich stated they are still working on the Mississippi trying to find old surveying markers. He brought in one for the committee to view that was a corner marker placed in 1918. Rich discussed the history of surveying in Crawford County from 1844 to present day.

Bills were presented and motion to approve made by Olson, seconded by Behar and approved unanimously by roll call vote.
