

**CRAWFORD COUNTY LAND CONSERVATION DEPARTMENT**  
**LAND USE CONCERNS**  
**February 10, 2015**

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Esser at 9:00 a.m. Esser verified the posting of the agenda. Members present for roll call were Henry Esser, David Olson, Wade Dull and Jerry Achenbach. Harriet Behar had an excused absence.

A motion was made by Olson to approve the agenda as posted and minutes as mailed. Achenbach seconded. Motion carried.

**GIGI COLLINS, Property Lister**

Gigi distributed copies of the list of properties being foreclosed on due to delinquent taxes. In total there were 51 properties; 14 have been paid in full for a total of approximately \$250,000. No judgments have been taken yet in hopes that more will be paying as we have several homesteads. She presented an article on Gov. Scott Walker's proposal to change how the state conducts property assessment, moving from a system in which the reviews are done by municipalities to one in which counties or even multi-county agencies conduct them. She indicated this would be more costly than the current system of reviews. The workbooks are all out to assessors with the exception of Prairie du Chien. No CSM's and no bills.

**JOHN RYBARCZYK- Zoning and Sanitation Department**

John presented information on the Winneshiek Boat Landing Rip Rap Project off the Highway 82 dike road. Rock armor will be placed in 15 locations along 240 feet of shoreline. WI DOT is updating their statewide Travel Demand Model. They request a representative from Crawford County to assist in establishing baseline data. Dennis Pelock/Highway Department and David Connelly/Economic Development may wish to attend. There is a workshop March 18th in Dodgeville on Tornado Safe Rooms. The information was forwarded to Roger Martin. The BNSF Railroad high speed crossover/side switching track is under construction and will impact 0.028 acres of wetland at the BNSF Mile Post 244. The project is located in Eastman Township where State Highway 35 and County Road N intersect.

Bills were presented and motion to approve made by Dull, seconded by Olson and approved unanimously by roll call vote.

**RICH MARKS- Surveyor**

Rich indicated he is finished working on Freeman Township and hopes to be done with Ferryville by the end of March.

Bills were presented and motion to approve made by Olson, seconded by Dull and approved unanimously by roll call vote.
