The meeting was called to order by Chairman Dave Olson at 9:05 a.m. Olson verified the posting of the agenda. Members present for roll call were Bob Standorf, Wade Dull (by Zoom), Kim Moret (by Zoom) and Gary Koch was introduced and welcomed to the committee.

GIGI COLLINS, Property Lister

Collins stated she is currently working on the grant for the Lidar project. The office is open to the public again, and surveyors are starting to come in.

Town of Seneca Assessor's Plat

Collins passed out maps to members present in the meeting and gave a brief background regarding mapping issues in the Town of Seneca. When laying out the property boundaries for a survey that was filed Collins discovered the occupying lines do not match the existing deeds on record. Collins researched the possibility of having the County Board order and assessor's plat to establish the occupied lines. The committee advised Collins to send an informational letter to the property owners effected and put it on the agenda for next month for more discussion.

Shedivy handed out to the committee members present an annual report from his office and discussed it with the committee. It was a busy year, 157 sanitary permits were issued and 143 soil test filed. Shedivy informed the committee he was contacted by a Bug Tussel representative regarding the Counties ordinance and what is in the State Statues. The Counties ordinance is not in line with the States Statues therefore only part of the Counties ordinance is enforceable. No application has been submitted yet by Bug Tussel.

Ellen Brooks Crawford Stewardship Project stated it is hard to hear the meeting on Zoom and asked if microphones could be given to those speaking. Troester informed Brooks microphones are being used but will see what he can do to improve the sound for the next meeting.
