Part-time Bus Driver

The Aging & Disability Resource Center (ADRC) serving Crawford County is accepting applications for a part-time bus driver.

DUTIES: Transport elderly and disabled individuals to and from home to senior dining sites, medical appointments, and shopping and recreation events utilizing a minivan or mini-bus. This includes properly operating the wheelchair lift. Responsible for basic record keeping, refueling the vehicle, and deliveries to senior dining staff, including office forms and site supplies on regular routes.

REQUIREMENTS: Valid driver's license with a clean driving record and be able to pass a background check.

Starting wage is \$11.08 per hour with a potential of an increase in hourly pay after one year of successful completion.
