

Public Safety Minutes
October 9, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Chairman Kersten Rocksvold. Committee members Greg Russell, Brad Steiner, Don Stirling and Carl Orr were present. Also in attendance were Sheriff Dale McCullick, 911 Coordinator Julie Cipra, Coroner Joe Morovits, Emergency Management Jim Hackett, Cindy Riniker, RN and Administrative Assistant Joyce Fritsche-Roberts.

The meeting was verified as having been properly posted. Next meeting is November 13, 2018.

Motion by Russell, second by Stirling to approve the minutes of the September meeting. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

Coroner: Motion by Russell, second by Stirling to approve the Coroner bills. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

911 Coordinator: A part time dispatcher was hired and started on October 1st. Baycom is finishing up with the R56 grounding at the Seneca and Wauzeka tower sites as well as the TxRx filtering at the Wauzeka tower.

All of the quotes for the new 911 system are in except one additional hosted solution quote which is expected by October 19th. A hosted solution will be much cheaper than an on premise solution so it is worth waiting for.

Motion by Steiner, second by Orr to approve the 911 bills. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

Emergency Management:

FEMA was in Crawford County for 2 days to assess flood damage. Cost of sand bags will be covered 75% FEMA, 12.5% WI Emergency Management and 12.5% county.

Motion by Steiner, second by Orr to approve the Emergency Management bills. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

Public Health: A policy will be set in place for after flood cleanup of houses with mold. Going forward a professional service will be hired.

School flu clinics will start October 19th.

Sheriff: Two employees are on extended medical leave. Lt. Investigator Jaden McCullick has resigned effective December 3, 2018.

Motion by Steiner second by Russell to approve the Sheriff's' bills and bank statements. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

Adjournment: Motion by Russell, second by Orr to adjourn. The motion carried with no negative votes cast and the meeting adjourned at 10:00 a.m.
