

Public Safety Minutes
February 14, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Chairman Kersten Rocksvold. Committee members Greg Russell, Mary Jane Faas, Brad Steiner and Don Stirling were present. Also in attendance were Sheriff Dale McCullick, Coroner Joe Morovits, 911 Coordinator Julie Cipra, Emergency Management Director Jim Hackett, Public Health Director Gloria Wall and Administrative Assistant Joyce Fritsche-Roberts.

The meeting was verified as having been properly posted. Next meeting is March 14, 2017.

Motion by Steiner, second by Russell to approve the minutes of the January meeting. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

Public Health: Family Assistance Program will be held in LaCrosse May 4th. The Coroner, Emergency Government, Law Enforcement, and Public Health are involved. Crawford County Family Assistance Center is at Hoffman Hall.

Coroner: Motion by Faas, second by Stirling to approve the Coroner's bills. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

911 Coordinator: Elizabeth Gilman was hired as a part time dispatcher.

IP cabling is under way at the Law Enforcement Center and done at the Administration Building. The phone system will be complete in March.

Vesta and Emergency Call Works will provide a demo for the 911 system.

Motion by Steiner, second by Faas to approve the 911 bills. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

Emergency Management: The SW Region will have a tabletop exercise on Cyber Security in Wisconsin Dells on Wednesday and Thursday this week.

Five homes required sandbagging because of warm weather, frozen ground and snow melt. Prairie Sand & Gravel donated the sand and Bridgeport Fire Department assisted the county?

FEMA requires that all mutual aid paperwork be submitted for county reimbursement. The CDBG is administered by Community Development Authority /Dale Klemme.

A car overturned in Baker Creek. Up to 20 gallons of fuel spilled. The State of Wisconsin Spill Coordinator was contacted.

Motion by Steiner, second by Stirling to approve the Emergency Management bills. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

Sheriff: Dale discussed the overcrowding in the jail. Inmate monitoring systems have been researched, but cell service is not available for the units.

Motion by Russell, second by Faas to approve the Sheriff's' bills and bank statements. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

Adjournment: Motion by Russell, second by Faas to adjourn. The motion carried with no negative votes cast and the meeting was adjourned at 10:24 a.m.
