

Public Safety Minutes
July 11, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Chairman Kersten Rocksvold. Committee members Greg Russell, Brad Steiner and Don Stirling were present. Also in attendance were Sheriff Dale McCullick, Coroner Joe Morovits, Emergency Management Director Jim Hackett, 911 Coordinator Julie Cipra, and Administrative Assistant Joyce Fritsche-Roberts. Absent were Carl Orr and Public Health Director Gloria Wall.

The meeting was verified as having been properly posted. Next meeting is August 8, 2017.

Motion by Russell, second by Stirling to approve the minutes of the June meeting. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

Public Health: No report

Coroner: Motion by Steiner, second by Stirling to approve the Coroner's bills. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

911 Coordinator: Emily Pedley Fecht was hired as a day jailer. Applications to fill Emily's dispatch position closes on July 17. Testing and preliminary interviews will be held that week with final hiring at Personnel on July 26th.

Julie will be meeting with CenturyLink to review the Vesta quote and discuss possible 911 network solutions and costs.

Things are still moving forward with Alliant on the Prairie du Chien tower site. The tower study must be done by an approved vendor through Alliant. Our radio engineer with Baycom is working with them.

Julie will meet with Public Property on Thursday to discuss selling the old generators from the Seneca and PDC tower site.

Motion by Russell, second by Stirling to approve the 911 bills. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

Emergency Management: The audit of Click It or Ticket and Speed grants took place. The State complimented this department for the outstanding job that was done.

Jim will teach grant writing at the Highway Safety Governor's Conference held in Appleton on August 22-24.

FEMA assigned a new representative for this region. Changes were made to projects initially agreed upon from the June, 2016 flood. WI and Crawford County Emergency Management have appealed those changes.

Motion by Steiner, second by Russell to approve the Emergency Management bills. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

Sheriff: Deputies used the Taser in two different incidences.

The Sheriff's office will be providing security for Country on the River Music Fest held August 3-5. The State will provide the Command Post.

Motion by Russell, second by Steiner to approve the Sheriff's' bills and bank statements. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

Adjournment: Motion by Russell, second by Steiner to adjourn. The motion carried with no negative votes cast and the meeting was adjourned at 10:05 a.m.
