The three county coalition is now the Driftless Area Water Study (DAWS). Agencies involved are Land Conservation, Land Stewardship, UW Extension and Public Health. Grants will be explored.

**Sheriff:** Deputies have started using the i-CrimeFighter program.

There has been an increase number of break-ins on County K.

The Sheriff reported on the cost to the schools for the School Resource Officer.

Motion by Orr, second by Stirling to inform County Clerk to disregard benefit repayment request from past employee, Dwight Kussmal.

Motion by Steiner, second by Orr to create a policy for flex plan clarification upon employee separation.

Motion by Orr, second by Russell to approve the Sheriff's' bills and bank statements. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.
