

Public Safety Minutes
March 14, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Chairman Kersten Rocksvold. Committee members Greg Russell, Mary Jane Faas, Brad Steiner and Don Stirling were present. Also in attendance were Sheriff Dale McCullick, Coroner Joe Morovits, Emergency Management Director Jim Hackett and Administrative Assistant Joyce Fritsche-Roberts. Absent were 911 Coordinator Julie Cipra and Public Health Director Gloria Wall.

The meeting was verified as having been properly posted. Next meeting is April 11, 2017.

Motion by Steiner, second by Sterling to approve the minutes of the February meeting. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

Public Health: No report

Coroner: Joe will be attending the WCMEA Spring Conference April 2-5 in Green Bay. Motion by Steiner, second by Faas to approve the Coroner's bills. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

911 Coordinator: No report

Emergency Management: A Memo of Understanding (MOU) between emergency service providers and local gas stations would give emergency personnel priority to fuel during the crisis. A new generator for the Law Enforcement Center will be installed. If the current generator expires prior to installation, backup generators can be rented from the Madison National Guard. Emergency Management command post generator could temporarily run dispatch.

Motion by Stirling, second by Faas to approve the Emergency Management bills. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

Sheriff: Through the use of landline and/or internet, two jail inmates are using electronic monitoring instead of having Huber work privileges at the jail. Inmates pay for monitoring, there is no cost to the county.

Jailer Lindsay Redman resigned as of March 31 after 16 years of service.

The RMS/JMS server was replaced on March 14th which will provide much more storage capacity than the previous server.

Dale informed his committee that the Sheriff's Department came in \$70,000 under budget for 2016.

Motion by Russell, second by Steiner to approve the Sheriff's' bills and bank statements. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

Mary Jane Faas informed the committee that today is her last Public Safety meeting. She and her husband are moving out of District No. 6.

Adjournment: Motion by Steiner, second by Russell to adjourn. The motion carried with no negative votes cast and the meeting was adjourned at 10:10 a.m.
