

**Public Safety Minutes**  
**October 8, 2019**

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Chairman Kersten Rocksvold. Committee members Greg Russell, Brad Steiner and Don Stirling were present. Also in attendance were Sheriff Dale McCullick, Coroner Joe Morovits, Emergency Management Jim Hackett, and Administrative Assistant Joyce Fritsche-Roberts. Absent from the meeting was Carl Orr, 911 Coordinator Julie Cipra and Cindy Riniker, RN. Russ Wittrig joined the meeting at 9:50 a.m.

The meeting was verified as having been properly posted. Next meeting is November 12, 2019. Time is changed to 8:30 a.m.

Motion by Stirling, second by Steiner to approve the minutes of the September meeting. The motion carried with no negative votes cast. After discussion the minutes were amended to read that the money for NG911 will come from the General Fund not the Contingency Fund. Motion by Steiner, seconded by Russell to approve the amended minutes.

**Coroner:** Motion by Steiner, second by Stirling to approve the Coroner's bills. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

**911 Coordinator:** Julie was at the Rolling Ground Tower site. Sheriff McCullick reported for her. The projects at Rolling Ground Tower are on schedule and completion is expected in October. HVAC units are installed at all four tower sites and just waiting for electrician to run 220 to them before turning them on.

**Emergency Management:** The latest flooding has caused \$2.3 million in damage to the public. Applied to Wisconsin Emergency Disaster Fund due to not hearing back from the Governor yet. Money is distributed as first come, first serve.

Motion by Russell, second by Stirling to approve the Emergency Management bills. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

**Public Health:** No report

**Sheriff:** Russ appeared before the committee to report on the jail inspection. Crawford County was written up for one thing which is to fix the showers.

Russ reported on jail doors and locks. Due to the age, replacement parts are not available. Steiner requested Russ get a quote on replacement doors and locks.

Motion by Steiner, second by Russell to approve the Sheriff's' bills and bank statements. The motion carried with no negative votes cast.

**Adjournment:** Motion by Russell, second by Steiner to adjourn. The motion carried with no negative votes cast and the meeting adjourned at 10:00 a.m.
